Discussed:

- How to arrange the meetings going forward. The class representative will be responsible for gathering parent voice to form the agenda for each meeting.
- Year Group Representatives will be invited to attend meetings.
- Agreed that one meeting be held every long term.
- Staff can be contacted via email or Seesaw if there are matters that need to be discussed in between meetings.
- Purpose of the meeting is to give parents a voice and allow an opinion/ideas to feed into the School Development Plan.
- Enables parents to make a list of important issues that can go to Parent Council in the future.
- Positive feedback can also be shared at these meetings.

Reading KS1 – Acorns/Bluebells

- Parents to support reading in Year 1.
- All parents need to be DBS checked before they begin to read with the children. The school are responsible for this. Communication will be sent to parents.
- Parents supporting reading in each year group starting in September will be organised in the summer term.

Little Wandle

- Little Wandle is a very specific phonics and reading program indorsed by the government. The school/pta have spent a lot of time and money (over £3000) buying into the scheme in order to ensure that children get a solid foundation.
- The e-books that the children are expected to read at home are based on the phonics sounds/reading area that they are working on and should be considered as homework. This reading should be carried out at an appropriate time with adult support.
- The children will also be given a book to read for pleasure which they can then read at a different time e.g. before bed.
- Parents should make comments on their child's reading in their Reading Journals and this should be sent back into school to be monitored by staff on a regular basis.
- As part of the scheme, a member of staff will read with each child individually one afternoon a week in Key Stage 1.

Uniform

• Discussed issues arises around uniform – further communication will go out to parents to clarify expectations.

Exercise

- Mile A Day (or suitable distance) will be carried out on PE days.
- Swimming Gala Mrs Higgs will look into this.
- New teacher in September taking on PE.
- Teachers are asked to run a club where possible.
- Where possible clubs from September, will be timetabled so that Key Stage 1 clubs and Key Stage 2 clubs run simultaneously so that it is easier for parents to pick up children.
- Bikeability takes place when children are in Year 6.
- Wherever possible clubs will be kept on the same day each term.
